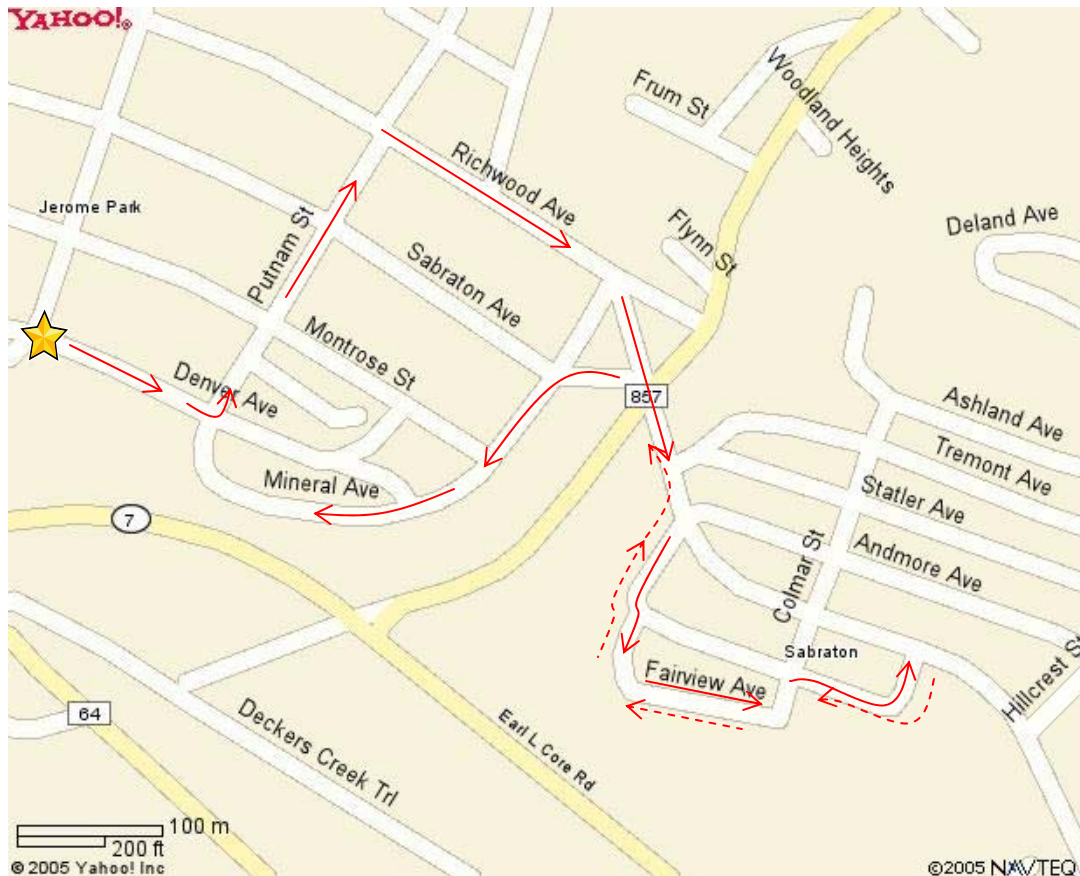


Jerome Park and Neighborhood Walk

1.0 mile loop or 1.5 miles route



Directions: Jerome Park is located off Darst St. in Sabraton. If you are coming from I-68, you want go just past the turn for Marilla Park at Earl Core Road off Route 7 West. Make a sharp right onto Mineral Avenue and go up the hill. Mineral Ave. becomes Darst St. and the park is on the right.

There is parking for 2-3 vehicles on the left after the entrance to Jerome Park.

Lighting: This is a good daytime walk. There isn't much street lighting.

Terrain: This walk is on city streets. It has a few small hills in the beginning, but the majority of the course is flat.

Route:

1. Walk out Denver Avenue, the street that runs parallel to the park.
2. Go **LEFT** onto Putnam Street (there is sidewalk starting here). Go out to Richwood Avenue, and then take a **RIGHT**. (The **1.0 mile loop** does not include crossing the bridge. Instead, make a **RIGHT** towards Mineral Avenue.)
3. For the **1.5 miles route**... walk across the bridge/overpass. Take a **RIGHT** onto Fairview Ave and then take a **LEFT** onto Mayfield Ave. There are no sidewalks on these last two streets, but they are residential areas with very little traffic.
4. Follow Mayfield Avenue out to Sabraton Avenue.
5. Retrace your steps from here and go back to the end of the bridge.
